Flu season has arrived.

This winter it is more important than ever to have the flu vaccine to prevent serious illness from flu.

Everyone over 65, children age 2-3 and those with long term conditions such as diabetes and COPD are eligible for a flu vaccine. **Please book yours now.**

All flu appointments are bookable online and over the phone.

During this flu season we ask that you take extra care of yourselves and your families. If you suspect you have the flu, we ask you to check that it is not Covid. Do you have

- 👉 a high temperature
- 👉 a new, continuous cough
- 👉 a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste

If the answer is yes, please get tested for Covid.

If you are suffering from the flu, here are a few ways you can help yourself to help you get better more quickly:

- 👉 Get lots of rest and sleep.
- 👉 Keep warm
- 👉 Take paracetamol or ibuprofen to lower your temperature and treat aches and pains.
- 👉 Drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration.
- 👉 Eat healthy hydrating foods such as fruit and vegetables as your appetite returns.
